# MANNING AREA WINTER SWIM TEAM BEHAVIOR CODE OF CONDUCT CONTRACT

---

## **PARENT CONDUCT**

As adults, we serve as role models for the children in our program. If you have a concern regarding any parent's conduct, please address your concern in an appropriate and calm manner. The Winter Swim Team Board, Swim Team Coaches, and Rec. Center Staff have set forth a policy of zero tolerance regarding workplace violence, physical force, harassment, intimidation and abuse of power or authority. Should a situation occur within the program or due to an inappropriate action by a parent, we reserve the right to remove the participant from the program, without a refund. At meets we all represent the team. With that in mind, parents must display good sportsmanship and use appropriate discipline when dealing with their children. Many adults at Recreation facilities are mandatory child abuse reporters. Use of a discipline tactic that is considered child abuse will be reported by them to the appropriate authorities.

## **BEHAVIOR CODE OF CONDUCT**

Rules governing behavior are necessary in order to assure everyone's safety. Participants are expected to behave at all times, show respect to staff and other participants, refrain from abusive language and causing bodily harm, as well as respect equipment, supplies and facilities. If inappropriate behavior is displayed, guidelines will be set forth to correct the behavior. We reserve the right to suspend participants (without a refund) whose behavior violates the behavior code of conduct.

## **EXAMPLES OF INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR (BUT NOT LIMITED TO)**

- **Abusive Language/Inappropriate gestures**  
The use of profanity, unkind words or gestures that represent them
- **Fighting/Assault**  
Injuring another participant or staff through force or physical contact
- **Disrespect of Coaches/Board Members**  
Talking back to or not listening to Coaches/Board Member; not following directions
- **Misuse of property**  
Improper care of equipment or items belonging to the department or other swim participants
- **Stealing**  
Removing items from staff, the department or personal belongings of another swimmer without permission
- **Spitting**  
Spitting on property, equipment or other swim participants
- **Teasing or hazing**  
Name calling, instigation or intimidating other swimmers; coercion of others to perform embarrassing or demeaning tasks.

## **STEPS TAKEN TO CORRECT INAPPROPRIATE BEHAVIOR**

### **Communicate behavior**

Coaches or Board Member will communicate behavior to the participant and be given a verbal warning. The participant will model the appropriate behavior and will clearly understand consequences.

### **Inappropriate behavior report, behavior plan, parent contact**

If a problem persists, the Coaches or Board Members will notify the parents or guardians. The participant may be asked to leave practice or swim meet. A written inappropriate behavior report will be given to parents or guardians, and Board Members.

**Expulsion**

We reserve the right to suspend participants (without a refund) whose behavior violates the code of conduct.

**Coaching Decisions**

Swimmers will sign up for individual events during regular season. Per Coaches discretion relays will be formed. Coaches have final say in setting up regular season meets & the State meet.
